British grandparents lose custody of children to homosexual couple

“Chloe was still little and although we were saying goodbye and reassuring her we'd see her soon, I don't think she fully understood we wouldn't be putting her to bed that night and we wouldn't be there when she woke up. But Josh knew and he was howling. He was holding on to me and saying 'Please, Granddad, don't send me away. I want to stay with you and Grandma'.”

Two weeks ago they learned the children were to be adopted by two men.

The thing is they were so happy here. They knew they were loved and they were safe. They had all this countryside to play in. They loved going on the farm with their granddad. They'd see deer and badgers and all sorts out there.”

The children are now with a foster mother while they are gradually introduced to the two men.

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Rutgers University Professor David Popenoe writes, “We should disavow the notion that ‘mommies can make good daddies,’ just as we should disavow the popular notion of radical feminists that ‘daddies can make good mommies.’ ...The two sexes are different to the core, and each is necessary – culturally and biologically – for the optimal development of a human being.” [1]
