Why not polygamy?

In British Columbia, two polygamous communities are going to court to argue that the reasoning behind same-sex unions is the same argument for allowing multiple marriage partners.

“If (homosexuals) can marry, what is the reason that public policy says one person can’t marry more than one person?” asks Blair Suffredine, former Canadian lawmaker and defense attorney for one of the polygamous communities.

Canada redefined marriage to include same-sex couples in 2005.
